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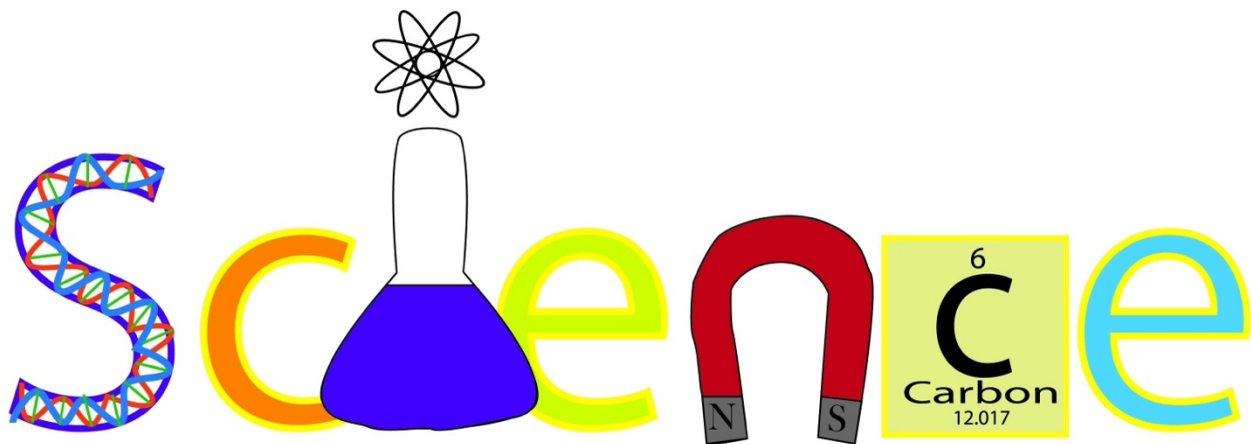
## Middle School Science – General Science

**General Science – (Recommended for 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.)**

**Monday 10:00 - 11:30**

**Tuition: \$450**

**Lab Fee: \$50**



General science is an engaging hands-on class that will equip students with general science knowledge as they prepare for high school level classes. The text covers the foundational studies of general science including chemistry, biology, anatomy & physiology, environmental science, ecology and more. This is a hands-on, team building class where students will have the opportunity to conduct several labs and experiments, work with a team, and participate in fun and engaging review games to enhance their knowledge. Students will also learn to complete lab

reports along with presentation skills. **Parents will be encouraged to have their student follow the reading assignments on the syllabus that will be provided. Students will be given in class vocabulary quizzes after each chapter. Quizzes will be graded by the teacher, but parents will keep track of all assignments in order to issue an overall final grade for the class. There is no high school credit given for this class.**

Field trips are optional and require an additional fee depending on the activity and location.

### **CLASS REGISTRATION**

- Non-refundable deposit of \$100 per class due with registration. Deposit can be made with cash, check, or Zelle.
- Full tuition is due no later than August 18, 2025.
- Monthly payments (beginning the month after deposit is made) may be available upon request, in good faith and integrity, at 0% interest with balances PIF by December 1st. A total of \$250 must be paid by August 18, 2025.
- If parents choose to withdraw their students from classes during this arrangement, parents agree to pay the remaining balances at that time and return any books or materials.
- **All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**
- There is an additional administration fee of \$50 for anyone requesting a tuition scholarship reimbursement/invoice.

## **FACILITY FEE**

- \$60 per student for the 2025-2026 school year

- **All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

## **CLASS POLICIES**

- Students/parents are required to notify the teacher/s if the student will be absent from class.
